

A Peaceful Retreat For Combat Veterans





On October 14, 2010, our son, LCpl Alec E Catherwood, USMC, was killed in action in Afghanistan. He was 19 years old. In June of 2012, we moved near Paris, TN and soon fell in love with the area. After spending time with Alec's Marine Corps brothers and other combat veterans, we realized that there is a real need for a place for these men and women to gather and talk with others who have "walked in their boots".

Here we are, in an area known for recreation and some of the best fishing in the south. How can we help? We can take the pain and loss that we feel and turn it into positive energy spent caring for our veterans. We have created a not-for-profit corporation and were granted 501 (c)(3) recognition. We are currently in the process of raising the funds required to build our lodge, and purchase equipment, boats, trailers, motors, and fishing gear.

Honoring our nation's heroes by providing a peaceful atmosphere for combat veterans to enjoy rest, relaxation and recreation.





This is a rough draft drawing of the future cabins. There will be five 5 bedroom cabins. Each bedroom will bear the name of one of the 25 fallen Marines from the 2010-2011 deployment of the 3/5 Darkhorse unit. We will also be building a 6th cabin for our resident employees, most of whom will be combat veterans themselves. In addition to the cabins, we will have a community shower house/dining facility. All buildings will be handicapped accessible.


Along with fishing on nearby Kentucky Lake, guests will be able to participate in woodworking projects and enjoy area activites


